Convening of the Municipal CBMS Coordinating Board (MCCB) with the Municipality of Ampatuan

1 April 2024 – Ampatuan, Maguindanao Del Sur. In connection to the conduct of the 2024 Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS), the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Maguindanao Provincial Statistics Office, spearheaded by the Chief Statistical Specialist Naldo G. Pendaliday, MPA, coordinated with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Ampatuan to convene the Municipal CBMS Coordinating Board (MCCB) at the Municipal Conference Hall, Ampatuan, Maguindanao Del Sur on April 1, 2024.

The PSA team presented the overview of the CBMS, its objectives, and legal bases of the CBMS, including the potential assistance that the CCBs could provide throughout the activity.
