18 September 2024 – Jolo, Sulu. The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Regional Statistical Services Office Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (RSSO BARMM), led by OIC-Regional Director Engr. Akan G. Tula, continued its public service efforts on the final day of the 634th Bangsa Sug Day celebration at the Bangsa Sug Ground. On the second day in Jolo, the PSA recorded 134 transactions, the highest number since the service began.
