(Security Paper). The initiative was made possible through a collaborative effort led by the Chief Statistical Specialist of PSA Basilan, Mahmur H. Sarail, who was present throughout the day to oversee the operation and ensure the delivery of smooth and effective services. Additional staff from PSA Basilan also contributed their efforts, further enhancing the team's capacity to meet the community's needs.

The CRS Mobile Outlet processed 150 transactions, surpassing the average daily volume for such operations. This strong turnout highlights the significant demand for these services in Basilan. Residents expressed their appreciation for the opportunity to secure vital documents locally, alleviating the need to travel to distant locations like Zamboanga City or other provinces.

As the first operation of its kind in Basilan, this initiative emphasized the importance of bringing government services closer to underserved communities. OIC–Regional Director Engr. Akan G. Tula reaffirmed PSA RSSO BARMM's commitment to expanding its services across the region, ensuring that every resident has equitable access to essential civil registration services.

Building on this success, the PSA RSSO BARMM plans to organize similar initiatives in other parts of Basilan and beyond, aligning with its mission to deliver efficient and inclusive services to all Bangsamoro constituents.
